Clerk's Report – 17 July 2023

Update on outstanding items:

Update on Aston Cross bridge repairs: Gloucestershire Highways have confirmed they 'are hoping to repair the bridge this financial year. It currently requires extensive de-vegetation work, so that we can properly examine the underlying structure. There is dense vegetation covering the wingwall and small tree growth around the parapet. Once this vegetation has been removed, we will perform a topography survey. This will help us to fully understand the bridge's structural condition. Once we have this information, we can begin designing a suitable repair. Once the repairs have been designed, work can commence on site. The initial de-vegetation work has been instructed and we are now awaiting a start date from our contractors. We have engaged the services of Collins Environmental Consultancy to ensure all works are completed in an ecologically safe and compliant manner.'

Replacement of the bin attached to the brick bus shelter in Aston Cross: The new bin has been ordered and is awaiting delivery – due 8 weeks.

Post box: Royal Mail has confirmed the post box at the junction of Fiddington Lane and Walton Cardiff Lane is to be reinstalled. Awaiting confirmation of date of installation.

Community Speedwatch: Training with an enforcement camera officer is being organised for volunteers – awaiting confirmation of date and venue from speedwatch team.

Defining and preserving community identities: Clerk investigating and awaiting feedback from Gloucestershire County Council.

Dog Bins for Pamington and Barleyfields: New dog bins have been installed at Barleyfields by Linden Homes. Clerk organising dog bins for Pamington as agreed at January APCR meeting – awaiting responses from Tewkesbury Borough Council.

Parish defibrillators:

The refurbishment of the telephone box is being progressed.

Pamington and Barleyfields Traffic Questionnaire: The online questionnaire is now live and the postcards to advertise it have been delivered to residents in Pamington and Barleyfields. Closing date for entries is 31st July 2023.
