PROJECT/ISSUE	UPDATE
<b>Community Governance Review</b>	Requested guidance from GAPTC 24th Jul. Chased 11th Aug. Awaiting response.
<b>Afghan Resettlement</b>	Meeting on 14th August
<b>Vehicle Activated Signs (VAS) to be located on B4079</b>	Installation of VAS on B4079 confirmed - awaiting date of installation. Await data from this before discussing again. Chased GCC 12th May, 7th July, 12th August. Should be installed in the next few weeks
<b>Barleyfields green space to link with PROW and A46</b>	Clerk team investigating opportunities to have path rerouted through upcoming local housing developments on land behind Fitzhammond Park and in Pamington. Aug - no further update
<b>Dog Fouling in Fiddington</b>	Order for three bins has been submitted. Approved by TBC. Enquired re installation date 12th August. Awaiting further updates.
<b>Traffic regulation order for unadopted roads in Barleyfields:</b>	GCC restated that there is nothing they can do until final adoption occurs, and there is no further update on the timescale for this. Requested update 12th August
<b>Child road safety signage in Barleyfields</b>	Clerk has contacted again Gloucestershire County Council regarding their response to request for permission to install sign. Response received stating an assessment will be arranged by developer. No assessment has been arranged to date (April 2025). Aug - nothing to update
<b>CIL: 3D modelling enquiries</b>	Discussed at CIL meeting. CIL Consultant, cllrs and clerk met with potential supplier to discuss. Quote received from consultant and circulated to members for discussion at Aug meeting
<b>Vehicles driving on paths and green space</b>	Gateway have sent plan for us to mark areas of concern and have confirmed that they can repair damaged bollards but not install new ones
<b>Provisions of grit and grit bins in Parish</b>	Gloucestershire Highways agreed to installation of grit bins in Claydon Lane. Site agreed - clerk arranging installation and fill of grit. To be installed in September
<b>Flood water monitoring for Natton</b>	Cllr. I Parker - local flood warden - to arrange. Deferred until winter
<b>Flooding at Walton Cardiff</b>	Cllr I. Parker - local flood warden is liaising with TBC regarding this matter. Aug: No further update
<b>Procedure for signposting and advertising requests from third parties:</b>	Clerk liaising with councillors to create document
<b>PROW upgrades</b>	ARPC had contacted Tewkesbury Borough Council (TBC). Aug: No further update
<b>CIL: Environment Agency</b>	the Environment Agency had suggested it would support ARPC in CIL projects however no further action had been undertaken. July: No further action required currently
<b>Defining and preserving community identities</b>	A successful meeting between ARPC members and TBC regarding existing naming issues and future processes. Aug: No further action required currently
<b>Emergency Planning document</b>	Clerk liaising with councillors to create document
<b>Wooden village gateway signs</b>	Clerk liaising with local Highways to assess locations. Aug: no further action required currently
<b>Replacement of the bin attached to the brick bus shelter in Aston Cross</b>	Clerk liaising with maintenance company to install.
<b>Community Litter Picking</b>	Added to the Community Engagement Strategy. Aug: in process of recruiting volunteers
